## ORDER

The slip opinion issued in the above-entitled cause on September 15, 2008, is amended as follows:

On page 2 in the first full sentence, the words “50 grams or more of” are deleted, so the sentence now reads: “This appeal is brought by two of those trial defendants, James E.
